Facility

The meet will be held at Countryside's 8 lane, 25 yard pool. There will be an 8 lane scoreboard and Colorado electronic timing system. Parking, building entry, and use of the facility will be restricted. Athletes, coaches, and spectators must:

- park in the south parking lot (by the outdoor pool)
- enter through the swim meet or front (F) entrance
- remain in the natatorium area, boys/girls locker rooms, and team areas.

Teams may NOT travel around the rest of the facility. Violation of these restrictions could result in the athlete or team being disqualified from competition. Please advise all participants and spectators of these policies.

Warm-ups and Meet Time

Warm-ups will begin at 1:00. Warm-up assignments will be determined upon receiving all confirmations, and posted on the Countryside Torpedo website at <http://www.cytorpedoes.com/2003/winter/meets.html> . Each team will end up with 25 minutes to warm up, and the meet will then begin at 2:00.

Entry Fees

Entry/Competition Rules

Entry is limited to swimmers competing for their high school. The meet will be governed by the *2002-2003 National Federation of State High School Association Swimming and Diving* rulebook. A swimmer may compete in a total of four (4) events, no more than two (2) of which can be individual events.

All entry times should be entered in yards.

Teams are strongly encouraged to submit their entries electronically using the Hy-Tek Team Manager or Team Manager Lite software.

Timers

Each school with 15 or more swimmers must provide three timers. Those schools with less than 15 swimmers must provide two timers. Timers should report to the meet referee at 1:40, or when called by the announcer.

Heat Sheets

Heat sheets will be provided free to the coaches; spectators may purchase them at \$3.00 a piece.

Awards

There will be two trophies given at the end of the meet: one to the boys team that scores the most points, and one to the girls team that scores the most points. These trophies will be "traveling trophies." Each year's winning teams will have their school's name engraved on the trophy.

Concessions
